Revision of the standard card

Starting with the March 2022 through May 2023 Bridge Bulletin, the instructions are presented for using the revised convention card, <u>https://web2.acbl.org/documentLibrary/play/ConventionCard.pdf</u>.

Notes from the March 2022 Bridge Bulletin:

- 1. The revised card is designed to help opponents to locate desired information and to help partnerships with their own agreements.
- 2. The new Alert Procedure has been incorporated.
- 3. It is perfectly fine to fill out only the areas that apply to your partnership.

Basic 2over1 card

The ACBL lists the 2over1 system, <u>https://web2.acbl.org/documentLibrary/play/basic2over1CC.pdf</u> and Larry Cohen's articles on its use, <u>http://web2.acbl.org/documentLibrary/marketing/Conventional_Wisdom_Lite.pdf</u>. Since this was published in 2016, the convention card shown is not the new Classic Convention Card. Thus, adjustments are needed to be in line with the new Alert Procedures.
